



First Aid Kit (must have two complete)

- Assorted sizes of non medicated adhesive strips
- Sterile, individually wrapped, three or four inch gauze squares
- A two inch gauze roll bandage
- One roll of adhesive tape (hypoallergenic)
- Scissor
- Tweezers
- Two instant cold packs
- A non-glass thermometer to measure a child's temperature with plastic cover for thermometer or alcohol to clean the thermometer, or a single use Tempa Dots.
- Two triangular bandage with safety pins
- Disposable, nonporous gloves
- A current American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) standard first aid chart, or current first aid manual, chart or guide provided by an approved first aid course for children and adults
- A CPR mouth barrier (face shield)
- Water
- Reliable communication device
- Liquid Soap

For Field Trips

- Emergency contact numbers for each child
- Medications, as needed, if the program administers medications
- Plastic bag for storage

Note: The facility shall maintain at least one portable, readily available first aid kit wherever children are in care. Including field trips, out door play area and one to remain at the facility if all children do not attend the trip.
