



Homework Policy

All children are given the opportunity on a daily basis to have a designated time to complete homework. During this time, children are divided into their age appropriate groups where they are able to work in a quiet area and receive help and support from our teachers.

All children are encouraged, but not forced, to complete any homework they have from school. If a child does not have any homework or is simply too young to be given out homework, alternate materials will be provided. This includes but is not limited to: age appropriate books and novels, math and literacy worksheets, and manipulatives to assist with homework incentives.

During homework time, a quiet working area is promoted and reinforced so that children are able to focus and complete their work.

Homework is never used as punishment and staff will never search a child's bag for homework if a child states they do not have homework.

If a parent or guardian has any concerns about how their child spends their homework time, or would like their child to focus on a particular area during this time, please see the Head Teacher or Director to discuss further action.
